KASANE / CHOBE

GAME DRIVE

Enjoy a 3-hour morning game drive in the magnificent Chobe National Park, spanning an impressive 11,000+ square kilometres and home to the world's largest elephant population.

Setting out in the cool of the early morning, you will have a chance to learn about the park as you witness a plethora of wildlife such as elephant, buffalo, giraffe and antelope, and if you're lucky even lion, leopard or wild dog.

Price: BWP 395.00 per person, excluding park fees.

Afternoon or private game drives are subject to an additional fee.



BOAT CRUISE

Enjoy a relaxing, 3-hour afternoon boat cruise on the Chobe River in Chobe National Park, where you will have the opportunity to see spectacular birdlife, crocodile, hippo, antelope and herds of elephant drinking at the water's edge. You may even get a chance to witness herds swimming across the river to Sedudu Island.

This is a truly unique experience, and the perfect opportunity to hone your photography skills as you enjoy the sun setting over the water.

Morning or private boat cruises are subject to an additional fee.



HALF DAY GAME DRIVE

Venture further into Chobe National Park on a 6-hour, half day game drive, where you will have a chance to explore additional routes within the park from early morning until lunchtime.

Common sightings include elephant, buffalo, lion and a variety of antelope. Leopards are more elusive, but you may be lucky!

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KASANE / CHOBE

FULL DAY GAME DRIVE

Venture deep into Chobe National Park on a full day game drive, where you will have a chance to explore expansive areas of the park including both inland and river routes.

Enjoy a lunch break at one of the park's beautifully positioned stretch points before you continue on into the afternoon for more wildlife sightings.

Common sightings include elephant, buffalo, lion, antelope and an expansive variety of birdlife.

CARACAL BIODIVERSITY CENTRE VISIT

Located in neighbouring Kasane, the CARACAL Biodiversity Centre is a not-for-profit NGO dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and research of wildlife, and is home to an array of fascinating animals including snakes, bush babies, mongooses, birds as well as their resident porcupine 'Coconut'.

This is an excellent opportunity to learn more about local wildlife up close and personal, to see what happens behind the scenes at the centre, and to even hold a snake if you dare!

KASANE / CHOBE

OLD KAZUNGULA VILLAGE WALK

Learn more about the local community surrounding River View Lodge on a walk through Old Kazungula Village, accompanied by one of the River View Lodge team.

Visit the local primary school, view some of the traditional methods used to construct homes, and learn about the customs and traditions of the local Basubia people.

FISHING TRIPS

In Kasane, the Chobe River forms the border between Botswana and Namibia and provides for some of the best tiger fishing opportunities in Africa.

Explore the river on a private boat with a local fishing guide as you try your luck at catching a mighty tiger, bream or barbel, whilst respecting the region's catch-and release policy.

CROSS BORDER

ZIMBABWE: DAY TRIP TO VICTORIA FALLS

Located a mere one-hour drive away, a visit to the awe-inspiring Victoria Falls is a must during your time in Chobe.

This activity consists of a return transfer from River View Lodge to Victoria Falls, allowing plenty of time for you to tour the falls (unguided), indulge in a spot of lunch and visit the local curio market in nearby Elephant Walk.

Make the most of your time in Chobe with a once-in-a-lifetime visit to one of the natural wonders of the world.

ZIMBABWE: HELICOPTER FLIGHT OVER THE VICTORIA FALLS

David Livingstone famously wrote on seeing the Victoria Falls for the first time in 1855 that "Scenes so lovely must have been gazed upon by angels in their flight". Little did he know that 150 years later he could have exactly that opportunity. The best way to appreciate the true splendour of the Victoria Falls is to view them from the air.

Known as the 'Flight of Angels', this spectacular helicopter flight over the falls lasts approximately 12 minutes and offers unrivalled views and photographic opportunities.

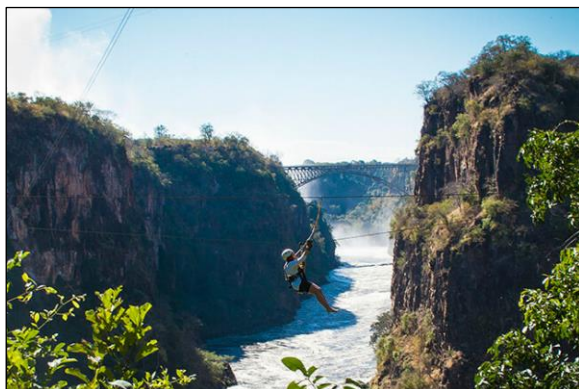

ZIMBABWE: ADRENALINE ACTIVITIES AT BATOKA GORGE

NAMIBIA: IMPALILA ISLAND VILLAGE TOUR

Located directly across the Chobe River from River View Lodge, Impalila Island in Namibia straddles the intersection where four countries meet, namely Namibia, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Botswana.

Enjoy a 2-hour tour of one of the 25 small villages dotted across the island, learn about the cultural traditions of the island's Subia and Tswana inhabitants, and climb the famous lookout baobab high above the Zambezi flood plain to behold an endless view over all four countries.
